Course Details

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This qualification reflects the role of retail sales personnel who will sell and demonstrate beauty or cosmetic products. This provides a pathway to work as a retail sales consultant in any business that sells beauty or cosmetic products and services.

The program will cover:

- makeup application
- eyelash extension application
- lash and brow tinting
- manicure and pedicure
- skin care products
- work health and safety
- sales and merchandising
- social media use

The School's fully equipped practical room ensures skills and techniques are developed through hands-on practice under the guidance of fully qualified and experienced teaching staff. The School also provides the opportunity to gain valuable experience through its own student commercial salon and work placement.

Prerequisites

There are no formal prerequisite requirements for this qualification. However, sound language, literacy and numeracy skills, basic computer skills and access to a computer with internet are required.

Programme Structure

The Certificate II in Retail Cosmetics requires completion of fifteen (15) units comprising ten (10) core units together with five (5) elective units.

Delivery

This course is delivered in face-to-face workshops with some self-paced learning and work placement.

You will be assisted to arrange a work experience placement of 50 hours.

You have up to 18 weeks to complete your course.

- Salon uniform or dark trousers and top suitable for completing treatments
- Closed in flat dark shoes
- Hair neatly pulled back if shoulder length or longer
- Jewellery – only stud earrings and a watch
